# What we will be learning In writing

In Writing we will be learning to use figurative language in our description; write a formal letter of complaint; write an alternative ending; create a narrative poem; create a persuasive text.

The books we will study will be Fantastic Mr Fox; Goldilocks on CCTV; Zoo





The Grammar we will learn will be types of sentences; correct punctuation for different types of sentences; paragraphing; difference between plural and possessives; adverbials; adjectives; expanded noun phrases; conjunctions.

## What we will be learning

#### **Maths**

We will learn to order three and four digit numbers; add and subtract four digit numbers; count on from a give three digit number in a give value; use formal methods to solve addition and subtraction; double and halve three digit even numbers; division facts to x12; use formal method or gird method to solve multiplication; use formal method or chunking method to solve division; find remainders in division; time to the nearest minute; am and pm; find time intervals; record and interpret data; construct and interrogate line graphs.
