What we will be learning In writing

In Writing we will be learning to write a recount; write a setting description using figurative language; create and perform a playscript; retell a traditional tale from a different viewpoint; .

The books we will study will be Cinderella of the Nile; How the Pyramids were built; Butternut Hollow Road; The Wolf's Story



The Grammar we will learn will be paragraphing; expanded noun phrases; different types of sentences and the correct punctuation; adverbs; adverbials; singular possessive apostrophes.

We will learn to order two and three digit values; know the value of each digit in money; add and subtract two and three digit numbers; use the inverse to solve problems; be fluent in our numbers bonds to 100; use efficient methods to subtract and add; know the x2,x3,x4,x5 and x10 tables; half even numbers from 0 to 100; double numbers from 0 to 50; solve multiplication problems; solve division problems with remainders; convert between standard metric units of measure; weigh accurately; measure capacity accurately; measure distance accurately; draw bar charts and interrogate for information .
