Phonics and Reading



We currently follow the Read, Write, Inc phonics scheme. Children will read decodable books that match their ability.

Children will have reading books that match their ability sent home.

We also use the Daily Supported reading Programme. Which is a structured reading programme that allows whole word recognition and the development of comprehension skills.

As the children progress through year two they will begin to use a more formal guided reading approach that is based on our Destination Reader approach in key stage two.

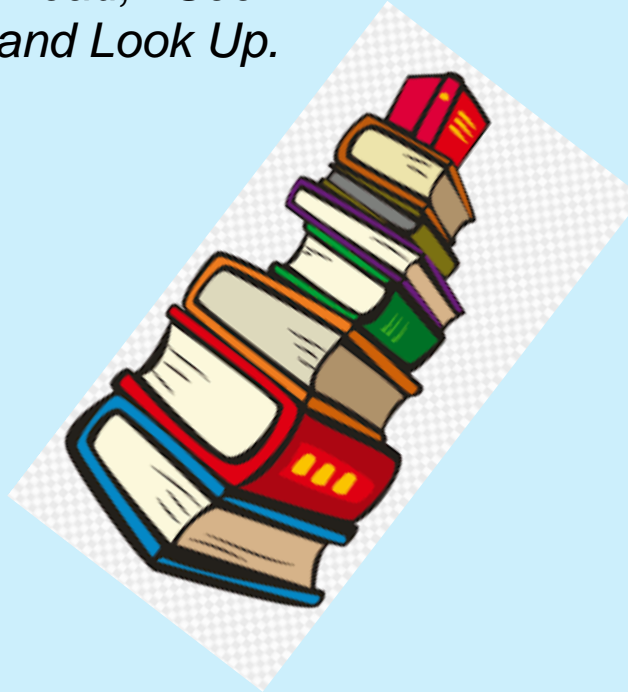


What we will be learning In writing



In Writing we will be learning to write a persuasive letter; retell a narrative and say what might have happened next; write a set of instructions; create an advert; write a narrative in the first person and write a discussion piece.

The books we will study will be

the Sun in Turkey and Look Up.



The Grammar we will learn will be different types of sentence; coordinating conjunctions; Imperative verbs; adverbs; possessive apostrophe; expanded noun phrases and the ly suffix .

What we will be learning

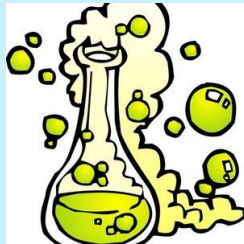
Maths

We will learn to count to 100; know the place value in two-digit numbers; make different amounts of money using different coins; count on from a given number to 20; properties of 2D and 3D shapes; simple lines of symmetry; o'clock time; days of the week and months of the year.
